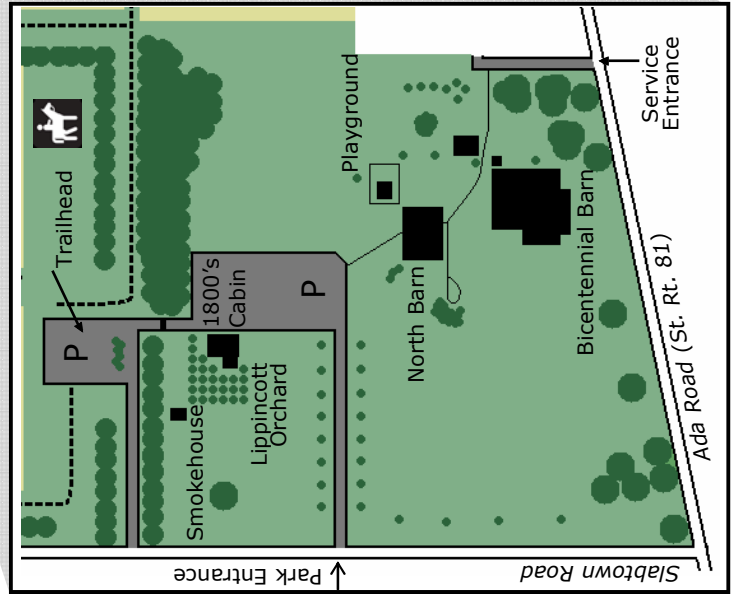
## Features:

The Bridle Trail allows equestrians and hikers alike the opportunity to explore the Allen County Farm Park via 2.65 miles of grass trails

The map below will serve as a general trail guide. Markers are also located at each intersection of the trail

## Bridle Trail Rules and Guidelines:

- ◆ Horseback riders must stay on the designated trail; straying from the trail or creating new trails is strictly prohibited.
- ◆ Slow to a walk or slow trot on meeting other riders or hikers.
- ◆ Be humane and kind to your horse.
- ◆ Hikers are permitted on the bridle trail but must yield to horseback riders.

# Information

The Allen County Farm Park is OPEN BY RESERVATION ONLY. Call the Park District office at 419-221-1232 for details.

The Farm Park Bridle Trail is free, open, and accessible to the public every day during daylight hours *only*.

The park entrance is located at 1582 Slabtown Road. To load or unload items immediately adjacent to the North Barn, use the entrance located at 3125 Ada Road, just east of Slabtown Road.

Parking and access to the Bridle Trail is located off Slabtown Road, north of the main entrance gate.

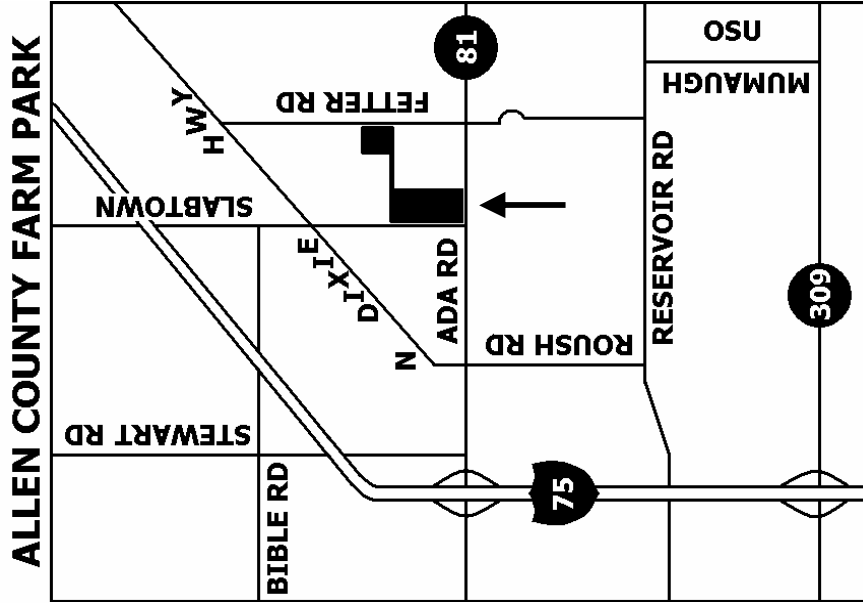
