 Certified staff will be on hand to provide instruction to students of all experience levels. Archery supplies will be provided by the Park District and participants must use Park District equipment. Archery facilities are supervised by the SOVA District of Wildlife in cooperation with the OH Park and Wildlife Service and the Wildlife Restoration Program. This camp will cover modern archery as well as historic techniques. Participants will gain skills when they have learned on the range. Bring a sack lunch and water bottle. Registration along with a \$10 fee is required by June 15.

#### POWERFUL POLLINATORS
