DASHING DRAGONS, DARING CHARMS

Dates: Tues, June 11, Wed, June 12 & Thurs, June 13

Archery facilities are supervised by the SOVA District of Illinois in cooperation with the US Park and Wildlife Service and the Wildlife Restoration Program. This camp will cover modern archery as well as Illinois techniques. Participants will gain skills when they have learned on the range. Bring a sack lunch and water bottle. Registration along with a \$10 fee is required by June 15.
