Hiking Series



There's nothing quite like a walk on a sunny, crisp autumn morning! Please join us for the 13th consecutive year of the popular Walking Thru Autumn series. Each week, 50-70 participants meet to explore some of the 29 miles of Metro Park trails. Upon completing 5 out of the 8 offered hikes, participants will receive a 2019 Metro Parks hiking stick medal. Hand-made wood hiking sticks and specially designed t-shirts will be available for purchase for \$20. All participants are required to pre-register by calling 419-221-1232.

All hikes start at 9:00 a.m., last approximately 1 1/2 to 2 hours and will be on easy to moderate terrain. September 7th marks the 50th hike, however, participants may register as late as September 21 for the final 5 hikes. After this date, walk-ins are welcome but will not be eligible for the hiking stick medal. Come enjoy the amazing beauty of fall as you explore your Metro Parks.
